Scope and remaining checks

Timely motions listed in Rule 8002(b)(1) restart the appeal clock. Rule 8002(d) provides a limited extension route but forbids extensions for the categories in Rule 8002(d)(2).

National-rule result only. Court, local holidays, closures and filing cutoff are not confirmed.

Method

Counting method	Count intermediate Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays. Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(a)(1).
Last-day adjustment	If the final day is a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, continue to the next day that is none of those. Check court inaccessibility separately.
Direction	Forward from the supplied entry date
Filing boundary	The usual electronic filing boundary is midnight in the court time zone. Other filing ends when the clerk closes, unless a different time applies. This sample confirms neither.
Filing cutoff provision	Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(a)(4)
Excluded procedures	• Separate-document entry under Rule 8002(a)(5) • Timely motions under Rule 8002(b) • Extensions under Rule 8002(d) • Court-specific closures, requirements and orders
